45. Chateauneuf-du-pape, Telegramme, Famille Brunier 2020	£85.00
Wonderful brightness and clarity. Harmonious, self-assured and complex without ever being heavy or cumbersome. The palate offers bright, sweet small berry flavours. Flecked with minerals and boasts silky tannins. An elegant and refined style of Chateauneuf.
